The Court has determined that *United States v. California*, No. 2:18-cv-2660-JAM-DB, and *American Cable Association v. Becerra*, No. 2:18-cv-2684-JAM-DB, are related within the meaning of Local Rule 123 and has entered Related Case Orders in each case (ECF Nos. 7 and 12, respectively). Plaintiffs in both actions have filed motions for a preliminary injunction (No. 2:18-cv-2660-JAM-DB, ECF No. 2; No. 2:18-cv-2684-JAM-DB, ECF No. 3). 4 a Stipulation Regarding Extension of Time to File Opposition to Preliminary Injunction Motions.

5 Having considered the stipulation, and good cause appearing, the Court orders as follows:

6 1. Defendants’ brief in opposition to the motions for a preliminary injunction (*United*
7 *States v. California*, No. 2:18-cv-02660-JAM-DB, ECF No. 2; *American Cable Association v.*
8 *Becerra*, No. 2:18-cv-2684-JAM-DB, ECF No. 3) shall be filed on or before October 30, 2018,
9 and shall be limited to forty (40) pages.
